

Chicago Lawyers' Committee for Civil Rights Honors Eimer Stahl with 2020 Pro Bono Champion Award

The Chicago Lawyers' Committee for Civil Rights will be honoring Eimer Stahl next month with its Pro Bono Champion Award for the firm's role in challenging restrictive voting rights laws in Indiana and for important election protection advocacy in Illinois.
